

### 1/ Le petit bac (at least 2 players)

The aim of the game is to fill as quickly as possible all the boxes corresponding to the themes in the given letter.

The game leader announces a letter. Each player fills his table in by writing in the corresponding column an element starting with the letter picked out by the game leader. As soon as a player finishes, he says "stop". Everyone stops and we compare the answers. The player who has a word that no other player has written scores 2 points. If several players have found the same word, each scores 1 point. Whoever found nothing scores 0 points.

Note: this activity can be done orally with young children.

#### Material:

- Sheet of paper and pencil

#### Production :

- Each player draws a table with the chosen categories (country, city, animal, fruit, vegetable, color, sport, first name, game, clothing)

### 2/ Noughts and Crosses(for 2 players)

The aim of the game is to succeed in aligning 3 identical symbols.

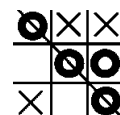
The two players must fill in turn a square on the grid with the symbol assigned to them. Whoever lines up, the first one, 3 identical symbols, wins. The alignment can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal.

Variation: you can also play on larger grids: 4x4 boxes, so you will have to align 4 symbols. 5x5, align 5 symbols.

#### Material:

- Sheet and pencils.

Draw on the sheet a square grid of 3 lines and 3 columns. Use or draw simple shapes (A player always uses the same sign.)



### 3/ Make a domino game

The aim of the game is to be the first to succeed in placing all your dominoes.

Distribute 6 dominoes per player, face down or up depending on the age of the child.

Spread the dominoes on the table face down and distribute 7 to each player (or the number of your choice). The rest is the stack.

Place a domino face up in the center of the table

The 1st player places a domino at one end of the central domino, one of the parts of which has the same number of points.

Each player plays in turn, forming a chain.

If one of the players does not have a corresponding domino, he draws one from the stack until he draws one allowing him to play.

End of the game: When none of the Players can no longer place dominoes, the game ends

#### Material:

- Boxes for cake, cereal...
- Pencils / rulers / scissors / markers

#### Production :

1 / Trace 28 rectangles of approximately 6cm x 3cm in the carton.

2 / Cut out the rectangles.

3 / Make a line in the middle of each to separate the two sides of the dominoes.

4 / Trace the points on each domino.
